

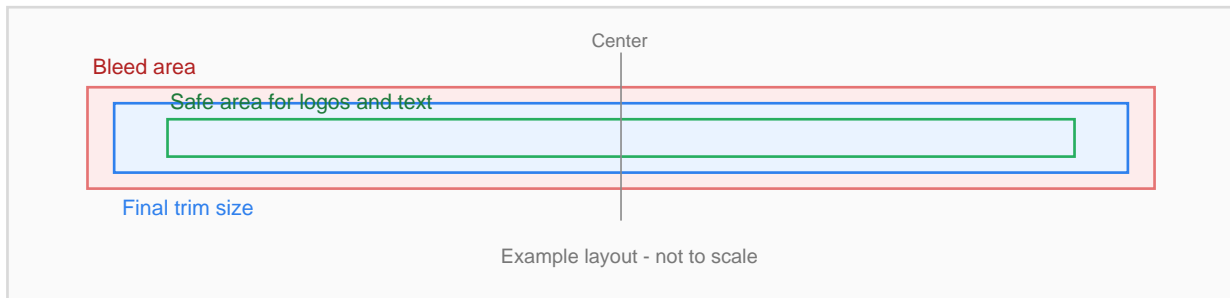
Lanyard Artwork Guide

Test PDF for print-ready artwork upload and template download flow

Before you upload your artwork

Please upload only print-ready artwork, a final logo file or a prepared brand file. If your artwork is not ready yet, use this guide as a starting point before preparing the final file.

Artwork layout example



Item	Recommended setup
Artwork size	Prepare artwork according to the selected lanyard width and total print area.
Bleed	Add at least 2 mm bleed on all sides where the design reaches the edge.
Safe area	Keep logos and important text at least 3 mm inside the final trim area.
Resolution	Use 300 dpi for raster images. Vector artwork is preferred.
Colours	Use CMYK colours where possible. Pantone references may be added if required.

Accepted file formats

PDF, AI, EPS, SVG, PNG, JPG or ZIP. For best results, upload vector artwork whenever possible. If you upload a ZIP file, include all linked images and fonts or outline the text before saving.

Print-ready checklist

- ✓ Logo and text are sharp and high resolution.
- ✓ Text is outlined or fonts are included.
- ✓ Artwork includes bleed where needed.
- ✓ Important details are inside the safe area.
- ✓ The file name clearly identifies the product and design version.

Note: This PDF is a temporary test guide. The final product-specific artwork template may include exact dimensions, print positions and production notes for each lanyard type.
